MAIN PURPOSE OF JOB

The Technical Coordinator is responsible for the execution of the maintenance plans, unplanned breakdown schedules, stores and services of activities between week 0 and 1 in order to support the maintenance teams to achieve optimization of resources and services to achieve the objectives of the mine maintenance section.

Key Performance Areas:

- Coordinate and execute technical details of various production or service aspects including planning, and execution phases.
- Carry out equipment inspections; draw up short term (weekly) maintenance requirement in order to optimize engineering down time.
