MAIN PURPOSE OF JOB

To operate a drill by drilling holes to prepare for blasting in accordance with procedures, in a safe and effective manner under the guidance of the Drilling Mine Overseer.

Key Performance Areas:

- Performs routine machine pre-start checks and records the identified faults to ensure preventative maintenance is done.
- Performs drill operations according to plans.
- Operates the drill to expected standards and specifications, using correct drill operating techniques to minimize downtime.
- Carries out post operational checks on the machine at the end of shift, as per standard procedure.
- Ensures watering and/or refueling of the drill are done timeously.
- Records drilling tally data on the provided drill log sheet.
- Monitors progress of drilling operations, and selects and changes drill bits according to the nature of the rock/surface using hand tools.
- Removes, changes and installs drill accessories when required using safe work procedures.
- Communicates continuously with pit control and Drilling Mine Overseer on current drill status.
- Checks if the area being drilled is properly barricaded off by means of cones and reports to the Drilling Mine Overseer if not barricaded.
- Adheres to all laid down SHERQ related standards, procedures, rules, regulations and statutory requirements.

Requirements and experience:

- At least Grade 10 with 24 points over 7 subjects with 3 years relevant experience in mining equipment.
- Code 10 (CE) or 11 (C1) Driver's License.
- Must pass the psychomotor assessment (Dover) with an A or B.
