## MAIN PURPOSE OF JOB

To produce long-term, medium-term mine plans and related planning documents to ensure the optimal depletion of the Swakop Uranium mineral resources, which support the achievement of the Company's strategic business goals and objectives.

## **Key Performance Areas:**

- Ensures that open pit optimization and designs are completed to company standards and requirements and that long-, medium- and short term planning meets corporate objectives.
- Prepares annual Budget and Life of Mine plan and reviews Life of Mine on a regular basis.
- Compiles Mineral Reserve estimates and Mineral Reserve reconciliations.
- Coordinates and incorporates inputs from various sections, e.g. Geology, Geotechnical Engineering, Mine Operations survey into the production schedules and designs.
- Ensures the development and execution of safe, effective and cost efficient short and medium term mine plans and production schedule.
- Manage capital and operating projects that are related to the ongoing development and improvement of mining operations including pit dewatering, pioneering earthworks, haul road construction.
- Implements optimum mine- and waste dump designs compliant with longer term plans and all geotechnical, geological and environmental constraints.
- Oversees the implementation of a short term planning model and schedule to aid in the production of the weekly and 12 week plans for production, waste strip, drilling and blasting.
- Ensures appropriate linkages are maintained between the weekly, 12 week and Medium Term Plans.
- Assist with the onsite development of a reconciliation system with other role players.
- Compiles monthly & quarterly plan versus actual reports & forecasts and uses information in quarterly updates of the medium-term schedules.
- Establishes specific site systems and processes to establish a short term mine planning foundation for Husab Mine.
- Proposes, revises and implements changes to SU policies and procedures relating to the medium-term planning and information systems.
- Develops and implements improvements to hardware/software, procedures and documentation associated with the mine's planning information system.
- Monitors and reconciles medium-term mine plan with actual mining activity, identifies problem areas encountered and prepares comments on variances / recommends solutions for the management team and off-mine reports.
- Establishes and recommends revised mining boundaries by selecting and analysing production factors and data.

- Establishes and Maintains Effective Working Relationships with Colleagues and Stakeholders.
