MAIN PURPOSE OF JOB

Responsible for all sampling activities at RC and DD drill sites, sample and core yard facilities, production drill block and in the field. Acquiring and collating physical samples with correctly inserted quality assurance and quality control inserts as per MRM SOP's. Ensure correct packing of samples for transport, recording of sample mass and radioactive dose measurements. Sample lab submission and collection from the laboratory. Assist with preparing rehabilitated sites ahead of Environmental Audits.

Key Performance Areas:

- Ensures all necessary sheets and plans are in place, including truck tally sheet, checklist and loading plan.
- Performs routine pre-start check for the ore composite demarcation poles and tapes, records and reports any identified errors.
- Performs routine check on the muck pile during the loading process.
- Replace damaged tapes during the loading process in a safe manner.
- Guides the ore loading activity according to the loading plan.
- Uses DGPS to pick up loading face (crest and toe) before entering a new composite.
- Ensures the floor elevation on ore composite is as per target.
- Ensures positive communication with Dispatch, Mine overseer and Assistant mine overseer over the radio, to respond or feedback the current loading composite status.
- Constructs and erects boards and demarcation tapes.
- Ensure all holes target for sampling are sampled according the sampling SOP.
- Ensure sample integrity is maintained.
- Dispatches samples for laboratory for analysis.
- Uses uranium ore detection tools for the purpose of grade control on the mine and to improve better control of production.
- Takes care of the instruments, such as DGPS, radio and torch, etc.
- Assist with pre - environmental audit inspections.
- Installs and lays out of water pipes for exploration works.
- Checks field equipment on a regular basis, e.g. generators and water pumps.
- Ensures equipment is kept in a safe working order.
- Ensures proper maintenance of a field vehicle.
- Performs Drill Core Processing tasks.
- Maintains equipment and facilities pertaining to exploration.
- Stakeholder relationship management;
- People and performance management;
- Safety, Health, Environmental, Radiation & Quality Effectiveness.

Requirements and experience:
