Responsible for supervising and monitoring the shift's Dispatchers in the usage of Dispatch, ProVision and MineCare applications as well as ensures data accuracy and upholds data integrity.

Key Performance Areas:

- Monitor dispatch and drilling performance via remote access.
- Ensure all critical MineCare events are handled and attended to.
- Assist FLM with the reporting and recording of shift HSE incidents.
- Encourage the use of all emergency functions as provided by the systems.
- Prioritize and direct maintenance of equipment in order to meet daily plan.
- Work in accordance with operations and MineCare to coordinate the movement of equipment in the pit.
- Use MineCare historic data to aid in analysis of problematic equipment and synchronize with maintenance workshops to plan for repairs.
- Monitor MTBF.
- Ascertain the functionality of the systems on all HGPS equipment.
- Monitor the use of the system by the operators.
