MAIN PURPOSE OF JOB

Responsible for the efficient operations of the Acid Plant, performs lockouts and isolation and complete clearance permits. Carries out plant inspections and performs work as set out in all operating procedures. Ensures compliance to IAEA regulations and SSHERQ standards and procedures.

Key Performance Areas:

- Performs start-up and shutdown of the plant and individual units using control system display.
- Coordinates and controls section and related activities of operating staff in accordance with laid down operating standards and safety
 procedures.
- Oversees and coordinates operational activities of the section by allocating duties and providing instructions and relaying information to relevant personnel.
- Ensures safe operation of plant and equipment including maintenance activities in area of responsibility.
- Controls and maintains plant process efficiency to achieve shift production targets.
- Continually monitors all process operation parameters and initiates immediately and remedial action required to achieve set production targets.
