MAIN PURPOSE OF JOB

To co-ordinate and control operational activities of the IX, SX, Product Recovery Plant operations on a shift basis, to maximise/maintain production through-put including quality targets within prescribed performance settings

Key Performance Areas:

- Co-ordinate and controls IX, SX, Product Recovery Plant operations on a shift basis to achieve throughput efficiency and production targets.
- Plans and Co-ordinates routine servicing priorities for the shift in conjunction with Engineering Maintenance Section, to ensure that plant and equipment availability objectives are achieved.
- Co-ordinates implementation of emergency actions and ensures that correct procedures are followed.
- Ensures that all operating and safety procedures are followed during plant start-up/ Shutdowns and initiates appropriate action in the case of abnormal plant conditions.
- Monitors plant production performance and initiates changes to balance and optimize process throughput as per schedule.
- Coordinates implementation of emergency actions and ensures that correct procedures are followed.
- Conducts troubleshooting and problem-solving duties on shift to prevent delays and maintain throughput targets.
- Constantly monitors the plant/system readings and data to ensure potential problems are detected in good time.
- Plans and ensures correct preparation of plant equipment and processes for scheduled maintenance
- Identifies and assesses production problems and recommends/implements corrective measures to optimize plant utilization and efficiencies.
- Monitors production of uranium ore product and implements corrective action to maintain process efficiencies within set parameters.
- Assists line management with testing and commissioning of equipment/ processes.
- Assists the Superintendent with the preparation of annual budget and budget revision.
- Leads and co-ordinates the work of team members to accomplish designated objectives.
- Coordinates all shift functions, plans and handovers as well as Acid Plant shuts.
- Ensures adherence to all basic safety, good housekeeping and environmental standards, practices, policies, procedures, rules and regulations, and implements appropriate action to correct deviations.
- Keep record of time and attendance and ensure submission to the Human Resources department.
- Identifies training needs and recommends training to develop subordinates' full potential.
- Provides on-the-job training and coaching with necessary emphasis on quality output and safety aspects of the job.
- Checks the progress of allocated work and assists employees to resolve problems.
