MAIN PURPOSE OF THE JOB:

To provide surveying services with the assistance of the surveyor operators and using the necessary equipment, which stakes out the location of ore grades, drilling, loading and dumping for the advance of mining operators, in a cost effective safe manner and in accordance with Swakop Uranium standards.

Key Performance Areas:

- Performs all mining survey activities related to mining and engineering requirements, in accordance with Swakop Uranium and Husab Mine standard procedures and accepted survey practices, on a monthly basis, by:
 - Setting out blasting patterns and block boundaries in the pit using survey data obtained from designs.
 - Surveying deviations from loading parameters.
 - Maintaining the spatial information and data sets.
 - Performing pit design set outs including ore loading block activities.
 - Updating any changes to the surface plan.
 - Installing grade boxes and sets up grade laser for pit floor and ramp control.
 - Managing execution of topographic surveys.
 - Designing and surveying all control networks on site.
 - Designing and conducting deformation monitoring and slope stability surveys.
 - Being responsible for end of month survey pick-ups and volume reporting.
 - Conducting precise engineering surveys.
 - Designing haul roads, pit slopes and stock piles.
 - Checking adjustment of instruments used by survey operators.
 - Monitoring condition of haul roads and ramps.
- Responsible for geotechnical prism monitoring and drill and blast pick-up and set out.
- Stakes pegs for ore grades, dumps, roads, pit bench elevation control, drilling and loading using G.P.S.
- Provides any mining related and general surveying services and maintains survey equipment in good order.
- Performs survey related administrative duties, to ensure effectiveness and efficiency of operations in area of responsibility.
- Updates pit mining advances and download data for drafting updates.
- Manages own performance and that of subordinates by maintaining and sharing professional knowledge and skills.
